E-mail Notification of Supervision and Regulation Announcements

The Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco is launching a new electronic distribution service that will notify you, by e-mail, of supervision and regulation announcements that are posted on the Twelfth District Federal Reserve Bank web site.

We will e-mail you a summary of the letter as well as a link to the full text of the letter and its attachments. The letters will be posted to our web site in an easy-to-print format.

In addition to faster notification of important announcements, this free service will reduce the volume of paper mail you receive. There is no limit to the number of subscribers per institution, and you may change subscribers or unsubscribe at any time.

How to Subscribe

In order to receive this service, you need Internet access and the capability to receive e-mail messages from outside your organization. Please follow the steps below to subscribe:

- You must access the web site from the same computer you want to receive the e-mail notifications.
- Visit our web site at <http://www.frbsf.org/>.
- Click on "Banking Information."
- Once on this page, click on the E-Notification logo.
- Select the "Enroll Now!" link which will open an e-mail window. Simply hit the "Send" button to complete your subscription.
- You will receive a confirmation e-mail. Please reply to this e-mail according to the instructions.
- After confirming, you will receive a final confirmation of your subscription with a message welcoming you to the list and you will begin receiving e-mail notifications.

After you subscribe, you will continue to receive letters by mail for several months. The Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco will discontinue hard copy mailings of this information by the end of October 2002.
