Prabal Chakrabarti joined the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston in 2006 as manager of Community Affairs research, outreach, and technical assistance where his mission is to promote access to credit, capital, and community economic development with particular attention to people with low and moderate incomes.

Prior to his work with the Bank, Chakrabarti served at the Initiative for a Competitive Inner City in Boston as Deputy Director for Research. Earlier, he worked in Economic Policy at the U.S. Treasury, as a member of the U.S. Delegation to the UN Convention on Climate Change, and as a manager at Ernst & Young. He also worked as a consultant to the United Nations Development Program.

Chakrabarti holds an M.S. from M.I.T., an M.A. from Oxford University as a Marshall Scholar, and a B.S. from the University of Illinois-Urbana as a Harry S. Truman Scholar.
