
How Much Rent Do I Need To Charge?

Affordable Housing: Breaking It Down

Objective: Arriving at a rent that is affordable to the target group.

Rents are a function of primarily:

- Operating costs
- Debt Service, i.e., the cost of developing the housing
- What "market" will pay

Value of the Section 8 Voucher

- Fills the gap
 - Family Pays 30% of income for rent
 - HUD through GHURA subsidizes difference between rent for unit and family's portion
- Reliable stream of assistance
- Selection of housing within the payment standard

Project-Basing the Voucher


- Attach the voucher to the unit rather than the person
- Rent as agreed upon between property owner and GHURA
- Eligible families pay 30% of income for rent
- GHURA subsidizes the difference between the family portion and the approved rent

Why Do Project-Basing

- Lack or shortage of affordable housing in desired areas
- Serve a special need group
- Provide for mixed-income developments

How Do We...



Basic Rules

- GHURA can project-base up to 20% of its voucher allocation ~ 500 vouchers
- Limit of 25% of units in a project; 100% if serving elderly, persons with disabilities, and/or families receiving supportive services
- Initial term of contract is 15 years
- Contract can be renewed
