

Composition of distressed sales by geography






Who Is Buying Properties? — November 2012






Unemployment rate in Washington continues to mirror national trend





Washington's house values at 2005 levels





House prices at metropolitan level





Seattle rents up, vacancies down




Areas Affected by Concentrated Foreclosures


Areas at Risk of Additional Foreclosures




