

Composition of distressed sales by geography




Proportion of Distressed Property Transactions—April 2012

Neighborhood stabilization: concerns over investor purchases of distressed properties







Unemployment rate in Utah rising slightly in 2012




Utah house price decline slowed in 2012





House prices at the metro level









Areas Affected by Concentrated Foreclosures April 2012




Areas at Risk of Additional Foreclosures April 2012





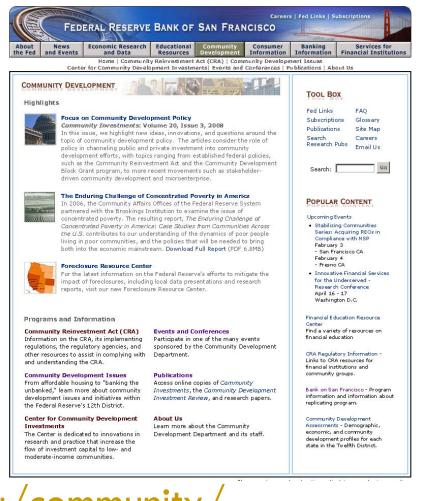
