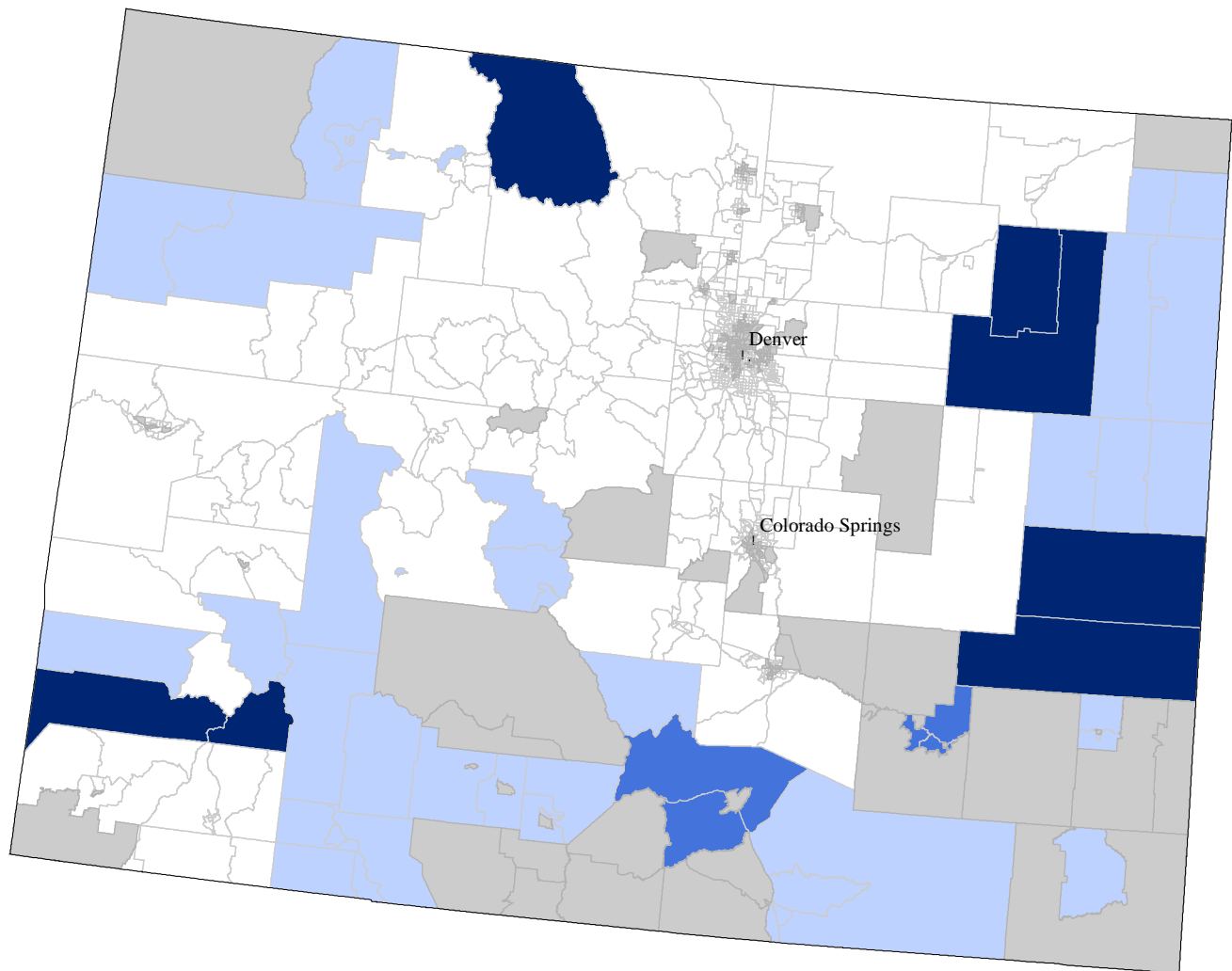






Middle-Income, Non-Metropolitan Distressed and Underserved Geographies Colorado
