Join with representatives of Native American communities in learning to design and deliver financial education programs using Building Native Communities: Financial Skills for Families, a financial literacy curriculum developed specifically for Native American families. Developed in partnership by First Nations Development Institute and the Fannie Mae Foundation, the curriculum is a unique tool to help Native people build on their own knowledge and develop personal financial skills while embracing Native traditions and values.

- ⊗ Develop skills in presenting financial literacy training using the Building Native Communities curriculum.
- ⊗ Gain an understanding of the design, implementation and outcomes of financial literacy programs and Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) campaigns.
- ⊗ Identify resources - tribal, state and federal - to support financial literacy and EITC programs.
- ⊗ Develop supportive relationships with other providers of financial literacy programs in Native American communities.
- ⊗ Receive a certificate of completion from the First Nations Oweesta Corporation.
