Federal Subsidized Stafford Loans Need-based, subsidized, student-borrowed \$120 **Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loans** \$100 Not need-based, unsubsidized, student-borrowed \$80 Perkins, PLUS, & Other Federal Loans \$60 Perkins: Need-based, subsidized, student-borrowed PLUS: Non need-based, unsubsidized, student/parent-borrowed \$40 **Nonfederal Loans** \$20




