

FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF SAN FRANCISCO SEATTLE BUILDING PROJECT FACT SHEET

Building

- Acquired 10.8 acres of vacant land at the Longacres Office Park, located in the City of Renton.
- Designed as a 3-floor building.
- The building encompasses 95,000 total square feet.
- The building footprint is 64,000 square feet.
- The building façade will be a limestone-buff concrete with a vertical textured finish. Large scale window bays will have metal-clad frames with clear-green glass and a shadowbox effect.
- Approximately 2 years of total construction time.
- Open for business in late 2007.

Functions

- The Pacific Northwest Regional Cash Operation will be established.
- The cash-handling system in the vault will employ automated cranes and storage racking for efficient retrieval of currency.
- Local administration and executive functions will also reside in the new building, as well as staff in human resources, customer support, police services, economic education and public programs, facilities, procurement, and information technology.
