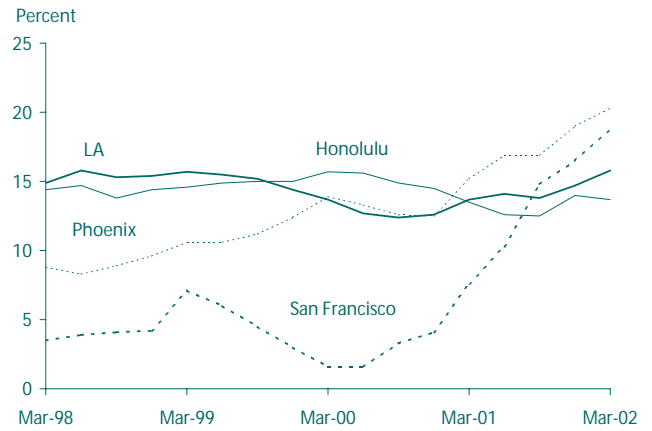

Metro area office vacancy rates



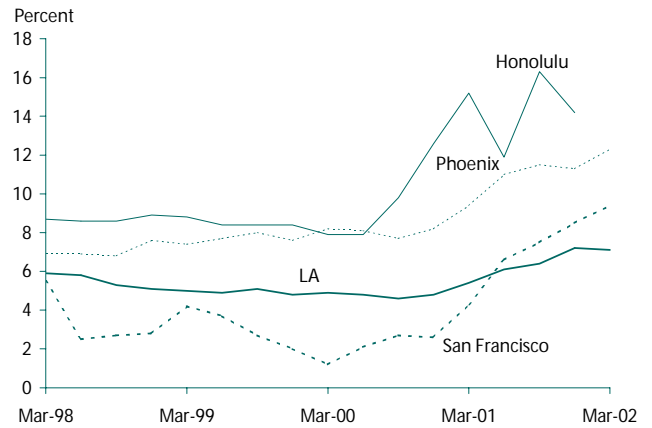

Sales of existing homes (percent change over year earlier)



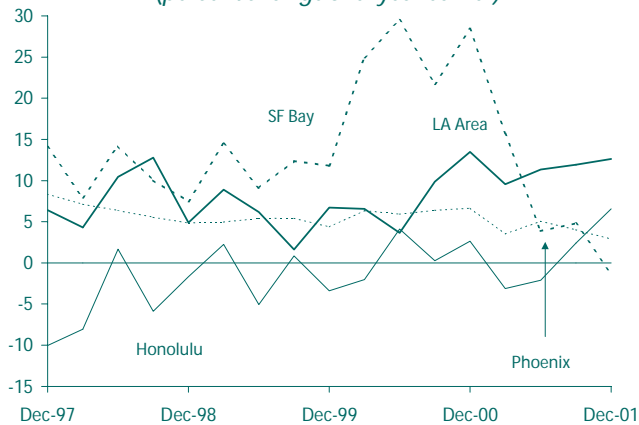

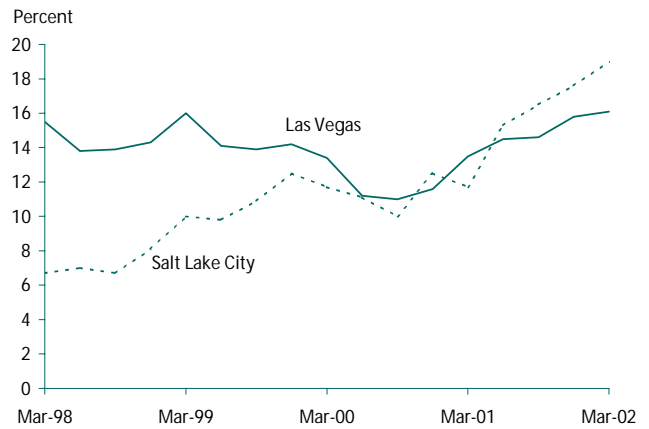

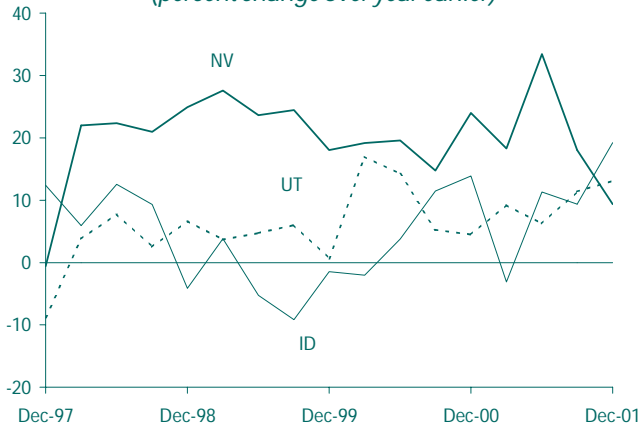

Metro area office vacancy rates



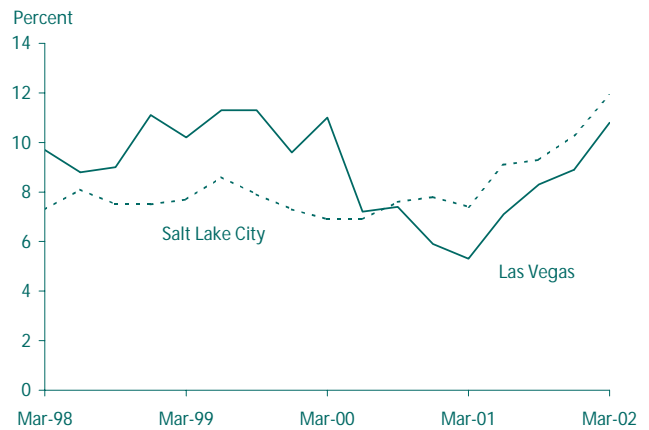

Sales of existing homes (percent change over year earlier)



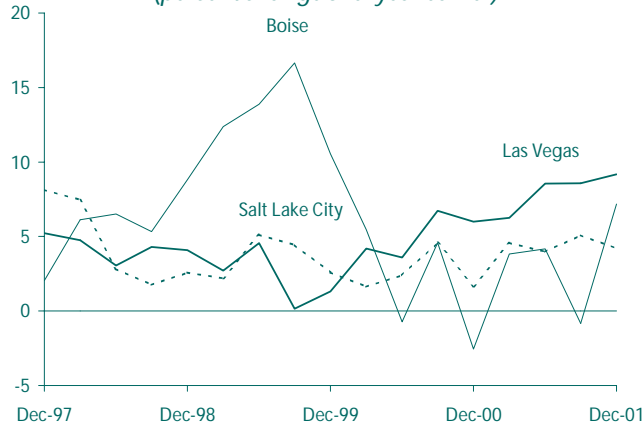
