The Stock Market Game (SMG) is a comprehensive educational program based on a real-life simulation of the stock market. SMG teaches about the U.S. economic system while conveying and reinforcing basic concepts in math, business, economics, social studies, language arts, personal finance, and more.

How does SMG work?

Student teams, in grades 4-12, receive a virtual \$100,000 to invest in stocks and mutual funds, during a fall or spring game window, for up to 15 weeks. Portfolios are updated daily with end of day prices. Teachers must pre-register their teams of three to five students at www.stockmarketgame.org.

Does SMG meet state standards?

Registered teachers gain access to a wealth of curricular resources to help implement SMG in their classroom. **NEW!!!** 18-week semester overviews are now available for Economics teachers and are matched to California state Economics standards. Teachers in grades 4-8 have access to a SMG Lesson Guide to help them get started, along with an 18-week semester overview.

Is teacher training available?

Teachers using SMG for the first time are strongly encouraged to participate in FREE training opportunities, either by attending workshops or participating in teleconferences in the comfort of their home or office. An online tutorial is also available at www.stockmarketgame.org.
