Compared to a White child in the affluent Oakland Hills, an African American child born in East Oakland is...

2 times more likely to be born low birth weight

21 times more likely to live in poverty

6 times more likely to be unemployed

12 times less likely to have a mother with a college degree

3 times less likely to read at grade level

2.5 times more likely to die of stroke

Every child born in Alameda County, no matter where they live, how much money their families make, or the color of their skin, has opportunities to lead a healthy, fulfilling and productive life.






