


12,085 PPP loans were made in Alaska

59.1% of Small Businesses in Alaska Received PPP




PPP Loans by Metro Type

Businesses in higher-income zip codes were much more likely to receive PPP loans.

Share of Small Businesses Receiving PPP by Zip Code Income

Low- and moderate-income zip codes were more likely to have less than half of small businesses receive PPP loans.

Share of PPP Loans and Establishments by Industry

Retail Trade, Finance and Insurance, and Health Care and Social Assistance businesses received fewer loans than expected relative to their share of small establishments.
