


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

68.6% of Small Businesses in Nevada Received PPP




PPP Loans by Metro Type

Share of Small Businesses Receiving PPP by Zip Code Income

Low- and moderate-income zip codes were more likely to have less than half of small businesses receive PPP loans.

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Share of PPP Loans and Establishments by Industry

Retail Trade, Finance and Insurance, Accommodation and Food Services, and Wholesale Trade businesses received fewer loans than expected relative to their share of small establishments.
