Need-based, subsidized, student-borrowed

Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loans

Not need-based, unsubsidized, student-borrowed


Perkins and PLUS Federal Loans

Perkins: Need-based, subsidized, student-borrowed PLUS: Not need-based, unsubsidized, student/parent-borrowed

Nonfederal Loans

Sponsored by banks, colleges, foundations, state agencies, student/parent-borrowed



Federal and Nonfederal Loan Programs


(Constant 2016 Dollars, \$billions)
