- 7. China's growth prospects and implications for other economies

The conference papers will be published in a special issue of the *Journal of International Money and Finance*, subject to editorial reviews for publication. We will also post working paper versions of the conference papers online. We plan to hold the conference in-person in San Francisco. Fundings for economy-class travels and two nights of hotel accommodation will be provided for one presenting participant per paper. In addition, we provide an honorarium of \$7500 for each included paper.
