## Toshihide ENDO

Mr. Toshihide Endo is the Deputy Director-General of the Japanese FSA's Supervisory Bureau, where he is responsible for supervising major banks, foreign banks, trust companies, and insurance companies of Japan. In addition, Mr. Endo heads policy making and implementation of prudential standards to ensure the safety and soundness of the Japanese deposit-taking institutions. Before the current status, he has worked, as a director-level, in various sectors of the FSA, such as banks / insurance companies' inspections, banking supervision, examination on capital market fraud, and human resource developments / budgetary and policy coordination of the agency.

Prior to his posting to the FSA, Mr. Endo worked for Asian Pacific Department and Finance Department of the International Monetary Fund. Mr. Endo received a B.A. in Law from the University of Tokyo in 1982 and a M.Sc. in Economics from London School of Economics and Political Science in 1986.
